

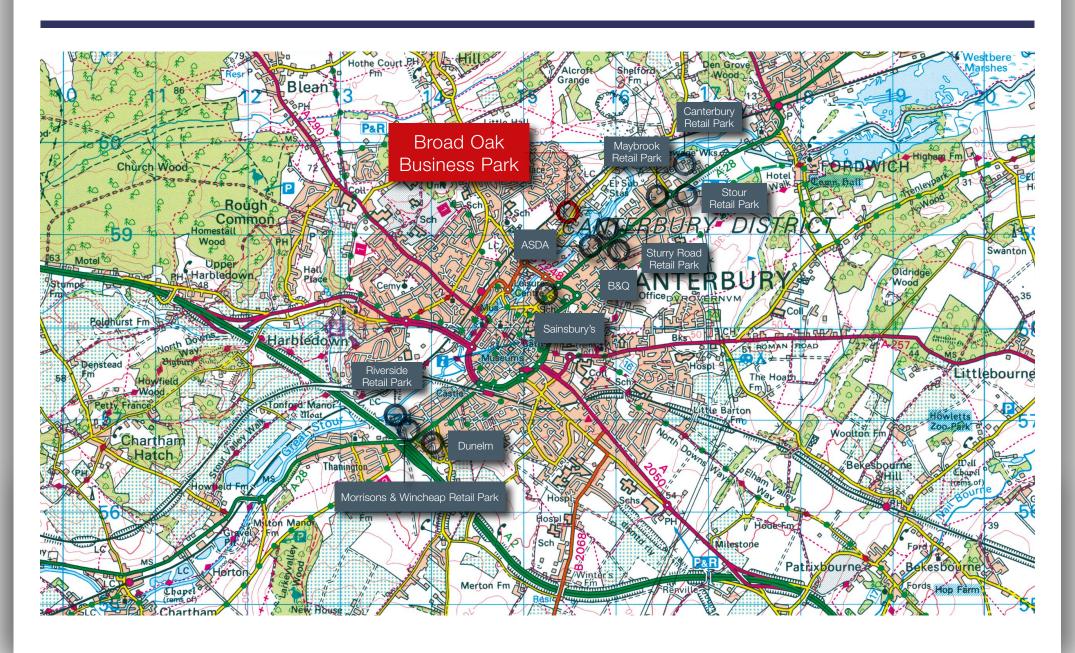

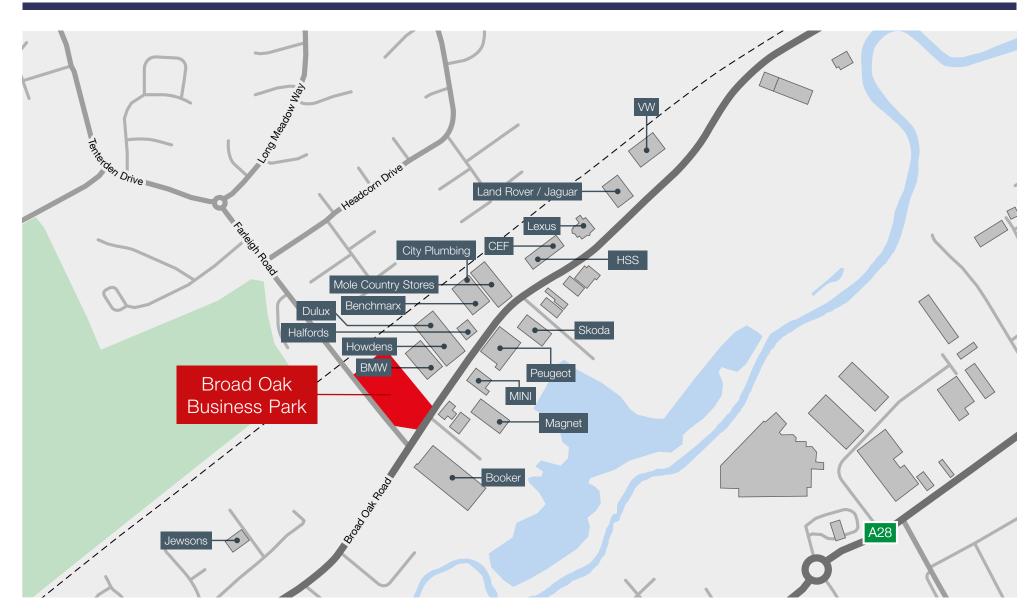

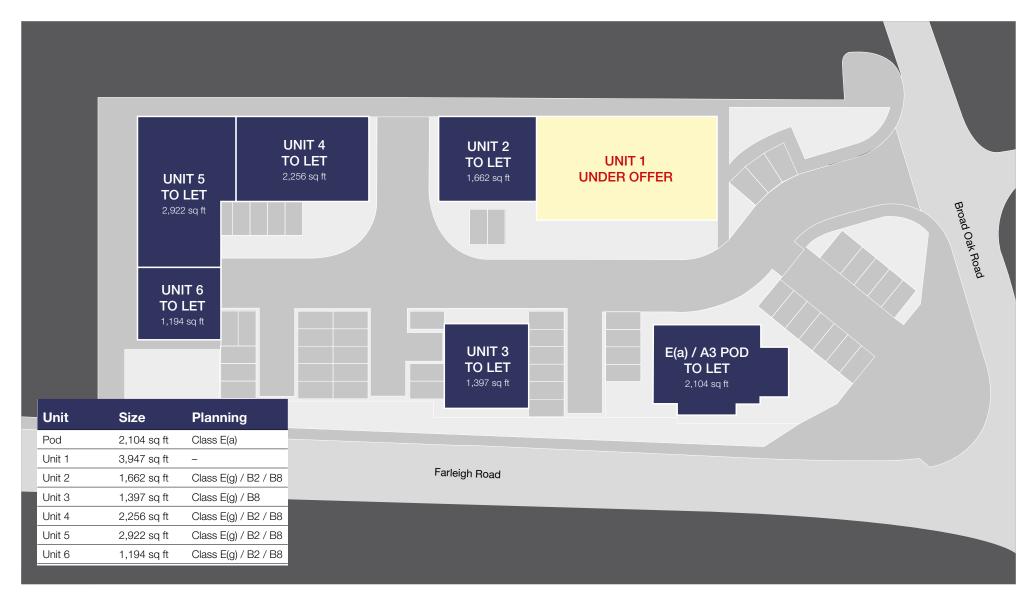

Location

Broad Oak Road is an established commercial / trade counter area situated to the north east of the city centre, adjacent to Sturry Road (A28).
